recycled mod paper

What: Wood grain paper printed with soy-based inks on certified recycled paper, Publique, \$5 a sheet.

Why: Because the design is so cool, clean and modern there is no excuse to use nonrecycled wrap.

What: Antique tins wrapped in exquisite ribbons, and hand-embellished with vintage brooches.
